**PLEASE NOTE:**

- Rates are based on the actual Length Over All (LOA), including bow sprit, swim platform, outboards, etc.; the manufacturer's LOA may be different.
- Any boat which is taller or wider than average, compared with most boats of that length, may be charged at a higher rate.
- No refunds for either Annual or Monthly contracts.

## **BOATEL OPERATING PROCEDURES**

Season is April 1st through November 15th; seven days a week (with the exception of Easter Sunday)

**Launch Service:** Hours are 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM\*

\*During the work week, **Mon-Fri**, if you intend to use your boat after hours, please call the office **by 4:00 PM** to have your boat launched before we close. On weekends, we are not able to take launch requests by phone.

**As a reminder, please do not forget to:**

- Install your drain plug before requesting a launch**
- Stow your antennae in the "down position" when you are ready to have the boat returned to the rack**
- Return trim tabs to the "bow up" position, fully retracted**
- Clearly mark any transducers or pitot tubes that may be damaged by the forks of the lift**
- Return the outboard or outdrive to the "straight-ahead" position when you are ready to have the boat returned to the rack**
- Have lines and fenders visible or outside of cover**

When you arrive at BJYY to return your boat after use, tie it up to our Boatel Pier. If you return after hours, your boat will be returned to its rack the following morning. Water & electricity are available on the pier for your use.

**Winter Season:** November 16<sup>th</sup> - March 31<sup>st</sup> - No In & Out Service

Boats to be kept in boatel over the winter season must have all necessary service work (winterization, shrink wrap, etc.) completed by November 15th. Any boat that needs to be brought down from the boatel racks for any reason after November 15th (if not blocked in by other boats that are wintering with us) may be subject to an additional fee; rates vary on a case-by-case basis.

**Shrink Wrap Disposal:** \$2.50/ft, minimum \$62.50 fee  
(customer or contractor is responsible for removing shrink wrap from boat)

**Work Racks:** are available upon request. There is access to water & electricity for your use; tools or hoses are not provided. If you are in need of more extensive work, please contact the office to discuss the type of work needed so we can determine if the work rack is suitable.

- Paint work of any kind is prohibited**

**Departure:** For billing purposes it is imperative that you formally check out with the Main Office to discontinue Boatel service.
